

Comparison Matrix for Home Survival Kits

Our *Home Survival Kits* are designed to support from 2 to 5 people in durable 5 gallon containers. Each kit provides needed food, water, sanitation, lighting, communications, shelter, first aid and supplies for at least 72 hours. These kits are designed to be used at your home following an emergency. While the containers may be transported during an evacuation, many prefer our backpacks to support evacuation scenarios. The majority of the kits we sell are our premium configuration; however, we also offer a regular configuration as well. Our premium kits include a 2 gallon water bag to facilitate the purification of additional water and radio/flashlight unit that uses no batteries. The *Home Survival Kits* can be lined with the plastic toilet bags and an optional toilet seat may be purchased that snaps onto the 5 gallon bucket, providing an emergency toilet.

Comparison Matrix for Home and Auto/Evacuation Survival Kits

Home vs. Auto/Evacuation Survival Kits:

Many of our customers inquire as to the difference between our *Home Survival Kits* and our *Auto/Evacuation Survival Packs*. As a result we've added the following matrix to help clarify the specific differences between these 2 kit categories. In general, our Home Kits provide additional items to support your family while still able to live at your residence. Now, based on the event and possible structural damage to your home, you may not be living in your home, but you still may have access to many of your homes resources. The *Auto/Evacuation Survival Packs* have fewer items included on the assumption that you are mobile and cannot carry a heavy backpack for very long or very far. It is possible to evacuate with our home kits and this is best done with a vehicle since the 5 gallon containers are not easily carried long distances.
